What is the Tournament Series? The Tournament Series is a summer program that enables experienced junior golfers ages 7-17 an opportunity to compete in a stroke play format with their peers. Each week starting June 13th girls and boys will play at a different course in Cleveland County and Rutherford County. Staff and volunteers will help the junior golfers with rules, scoring and etiquette.

What is the goal of the Tournament Series? Our goal is to provide an organized weekly event to encourage the development of junior golfers. The tournament experience is unique and our program will give all players a chance to fairly compete within age and gender divisions. We encourage each junior to reach their full potential, in golf and in life.

2016 Summer Schedule - You may sign up your child at anytime by completing the registration form. Our schedule will begin Monday, June 13th at Challenger III Golf Course.. There will be eight (9) tournaments. We will try and be consistent regarding the tee times of each tournament. However, due to golf course schedules we may need some flexibility. Most tee times will begin at 9am; please call River Bend after 12pm on Sunday afternoons before that weeks tournament for your child's tee time.

What are the Benefits of the Tournament Series? Juniors will compete on regulation golf courses designed to fit their age and ability. **Points are determined based on participation at each tournament. For example, if we have 10 players, first place would receive 10 points, second place would receive 9 points, etc..** Prizes will be awarded at the end of the summer to those that win each age group.

Costs and Registration Details- There is a Tour Membership fee of \$40 that is required to play in any Tour event. Then the cost of each Tour Event will have a \$10 entry fee. Space is limited each week; therefore registration is open until all the space is filled. **The registration deadline is the Wednesday before the scheduled tournament. To register, simply fill out the form on the opposite side of this paper and turn into the River Bend YMCA Golf course along with your fee.**

Awards: Prizes will be awarded to first place of each division. The other players will receive points toward The First Tee Cup Standings.
